

FROM THE DESK OF FATHER DAN

My favorite saint has always been St. Lawrence. Ever since my childhood, or for as long as I can remember, I have been captivated by his story. This is largely due to the fact that both my middle name and my father's name are Lawrence. In brief St. Lawrence was asked by the Romans in 258 AD to turn over the wealth of the Church. Instead of bringing money or gold, St. Lawrence brought the poor, the lame, the widows, and the orphans – the ones for whom God the Father has a special tenderness. The Romans, though, were not pleased. Thus St. Lawrence soon found himself placed upon a grill and slowly baked alive. At the halfway point St. Lawrence said, "You can turn me over now for I am done on this side." The combination of calmness and courage St. Lawrence displayed in the midst of suffering fascinated me; thus increasing my devotion to this great saint. Shortly after being ordained a Deacon in Rome, I was blessed to have my first Mass of Thanksgiving with Bishop Callahan in the church built directly above the ancient oven upon which St. Lawrence was martyred. Thus bringing to full circle my life-long devotion to St. Lawrence.

For me it has been fascinating to discover the many incredible stories of the saints. One of the major joys I had during my four years in Rome was searching out these stories and the many locations where so many great saints have been buried. On Saturdays (our free days in Rome) I would often catch a bus and go visit some shrine either in Rome or in the Italian countryside. Small chapels and churches dedicated to our Lord, Mother Mary or the saints were abundant in nearly every Italian town. I recall one time in particular when I left early on a Saturday morning. After praying a Rosary at St Peter's Basilica I caught the metro to the bus station. Once on the bus, which doubles as a bus for both tourists and school children, I rode a good forty minutes through the countryside to the small town of Genazzano. Leaving the noise of the school children, I hiked up into the town to arrive just in time for 8AM Mass in front of the miraculous image of 'Our Lady of Good Counsel'. It was a special moment to receive the double blessing of receiving Our Lord in the Eucharist and seeing this ancient miraculous image, venerated since the 15th century.

With these and similar opportunities a desire grew within my heart to assist pilgrims in locating the shrines and the tombs of their favorite saints. Thus during my four years I compiled a list identifying the primary locations of the tombs and relics of the many saints celebrated throughout the year at daily Masses and found on the Liturgical Calendar. This work locates the tombs and relics found in over four-hundred churches worldwide – even some in America and eventually became a book which sells on Amazon and a website located at www.saintsinrome.com

God Bless everyone!!!




