Our school was built in 1948 and sadly closed in 2004. Maybe you've never been inside and would like simply to see where so many children received their education. Moreover, the gym was the place of worship (what Catholics call the Mass) until the church was built in 1960. You're welcome to come and see the building – guides will happily show you around.

Our parish center (what neighborhood kids call "the mansion") sits on the corner of Thomas and 9<sup>th</sup> and was originally a convent. Built in 1955, it has served in various ways and you're very welcome to see the ground floor (and basement, if you're really curious). The Sisters left in the 1970's, but their spirit lives on in us.

Finally, our church was built in 1960 and could originally seat 850 people. If you're not Catholic, you're still very welcome to walk around and admire the architecture and the solidly built church where God meets us with His healing touch and indomitable hope.
