in the Most Holy Sacrament.

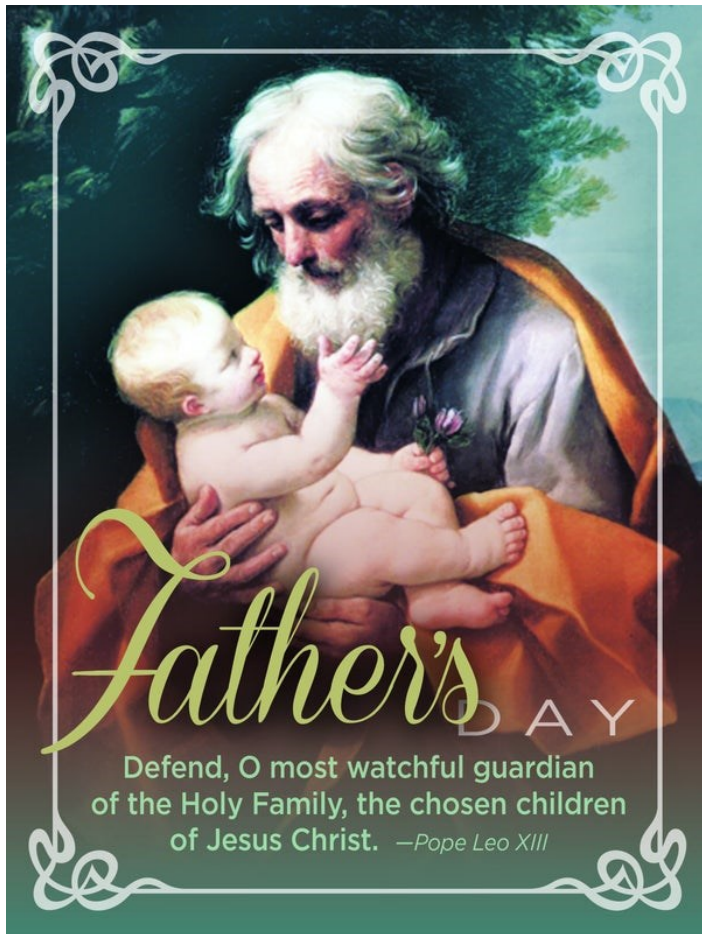
I love You above all things,
